Hans J. Wegner***

One of the most original furniture designers Denmark has produced is Hans J. Wegner. In 1941, he began working with master carpenter Johannes Hansen. Wegner, who was a skilled carpenter, had a seldom ability to construct and shape wood. His furniture is powerfully formed. Some have an experimental character, while others are finished: distinct and simple in construction, good in use with characterful solutions and delicate material effect. Much of his furniture has been innovative and has remained influential. He can simplify a construction and a design until it is precise and complete, without seeming unimaginative and boring. In his arm chair, it is characteristic that the arm and chair back are shaped from a continuous piece of ash wood bent with steam. The result is a simplification and elegance.
